POLICY PURPOSE

To inform students of Augusta University support services available to all students.

POLICY STATEMENT

All Augusta University students are referred to the University's Student Life Services.

PROCESS + PROCEDURES

- Students will be informed to the Division of Enrollment & Student Affairs for Student Life activities and website offerings during New Student Orientation. Offerings include information regarding student services, Campus Assessment Response and Evaluation (CARE), Community Service opportunities, Counseling Center, Student Conduct, and Testing & Disability Services, Campus Recreation, Residence Life, Student Health, and other policies and resources available on campus including the University Student Manual.
- 2. Students are encouraged to fully participate in Student Life activities to enrich their personal Augusta University experience.
- 3. The Department of OT offers the following student organizations: Student Occupational Therapy Association (SOTA), Pi Theta Epsilon (PTE), and Coalition of Occupational Therapy Advocates for Diversity (COTAD), that are advised by a faculty member within the Department of Occupational Therapy. These associations facilitate the student's orientation to a professional OT organization, service engagement, roles, and responsibilities.
