

DMD LICENSURE EXAM ELIGIBILITY

DESCRIPTION

In order to be approved to sit for a licensure exam, candidates must meet the following requirements by the end of the fall semester of the D4 year:

- Currently enrolled in academic good standing as a D4 student or Resident of Record at the at the DCG.
- Student should have successfully completed GDDL 5791 – General Dentistry Licensure in Georgia I & GDDL 5892 – General Dentistry Licensure in Georgia II.
- All expectations to proceed to D4 clinic have been met or exception granted by SARC and/or Associate Dean of Academic Affairs & Advanced Education.
- It is anticipated that all school requirements are current and up to date and the student will be recommended for graduation based on their current standing.

RATIONAL

This is being implemented to affirm that students/residents are qualified to sit for the exam.

OTHER NOTES

This criterion is being established to certify to the licensure testing agencies that the candidate is deemed ready to safely attempt the licensure exam from a CODA accredited dental program.
