ELIGIBILITY

Center for Undergraduate Research and Scholarship

- AU undergraduate students
- Full-time
 - part-time students will be considered if funds allow
- Enrolled in a UR Course in the current term (CURS, department, honors)
- Travel grants only (no materials)
 - Travel for data collection OR
 - Travel for presentation of research
- Must have a faculty mentor/sponsor/advisor



WHAT TO EXPECT

Center for Undergraduate Research and Scholarship

- READ THE CALL FOR PROPOSALS!
- Proposal will include
 - Your info
 - Mentor info
 - Project description
 - Abstract (for conferences)
 - What you've learned so far
 - What you hope to learn
 - Itemized Budget
 - Budget Narrative



TRAVELLING TOGETHER?

Center for Undergraduate Research and Scholarship

- Each student submits their own proposal
- Individual information should be unique
- Shared expenses (e.g., car travel)
 will be explained in the budget
 narrative.
- Read application instructions carefully.
- Ask us if questions



WHAT TO DO FOR GRANT PROPOSALS



- Edit for clarity and ease of reading (Ask Writing Center or CURS for feedback)
- Detail your experiences working on this research
- Explain your role in the research
- Justify the significance of the travel (why is it important to go?)
- Include detailed & realistic statements about your learning that match your experience level
- Write professionally



WHAT NOT TO DO FOR GRANT PROPOSALS



- DO NOT have faculty write your proposal
- DO NOT have Al write your proposal
- DO NOT submit an incomplete proposal
- DO NOT exceed word limits
- DO NOT be vague in your answers
- DO NOT use jargon that reviewers may not understand
