WHAT WILL OUR GRADUATES BE DOING 6 MONTHS AFTER GRADUATION?



55% will be employed part-time or full-time

- **46%** of those graduates will be working in Georgia
- **40%** of those graduates will be in a position that requires a college degree and is related to their field of study
- **30%** of those graduates will be making between \$35,000 - \$49,999
- **27%** of those graduates will be starting a new job



2% are already enrolled in a program to continue their education

- **11%** of those graduates will be continuing their education at Augusta University
- **67%** of those graduates will be pursuing their master's degree



30% will still be looking for a job



8% are planning to continue their education 6 months after graduation



2% will be serving in the US military

370 students who responded to the survey reported:

• **73%** would likely recommend Augusta University to an interested student

• **70%** of the 239 likelihood explanations were positive
