WHAT WILL OUR GRADUATES BE DOING 6 MONTHS AFTER GRADUATION?



48% will be employed part-time or full-time

- **81%** of those graduates will be working in Georgia
- **74%** of those graduates will be in a position that requires a college degree and is related to their field of study
- **32%** of those graduates will be making between \$50,000 - \$74,999
- **67%** of those graduates will be starting a new job



11% are already enrolled in a program to continue their education

- **41%** of those graduates will be continuing their education at Augusta University
- **41%** of those graduates will be pursuing their master's degree



28% will still be looking for a job



6% are planning to continue their education 6 months after graduation



2% will be serving in the US military

602 students who responded to the survey reported:

• **77%** would likely recommend Augusta University to an interested student

• **58%** of the 324 likelihood explanations were positive
